

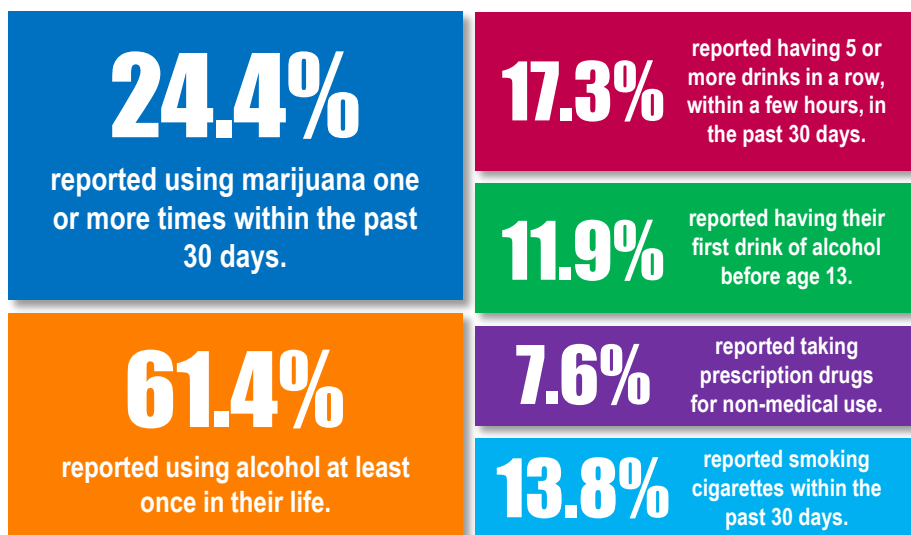
# Let's work together
